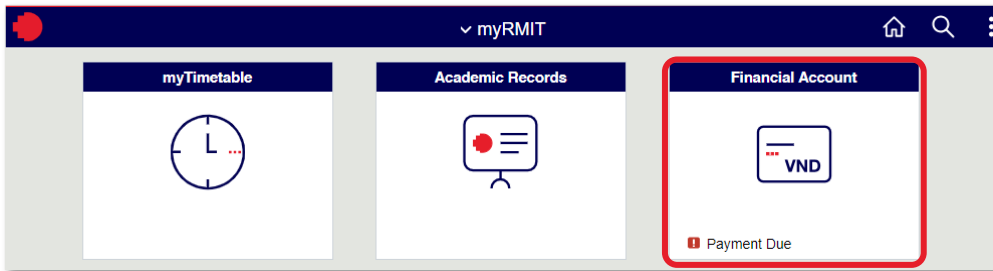

Navigation

myRMIT Home Page > Financial Account tile

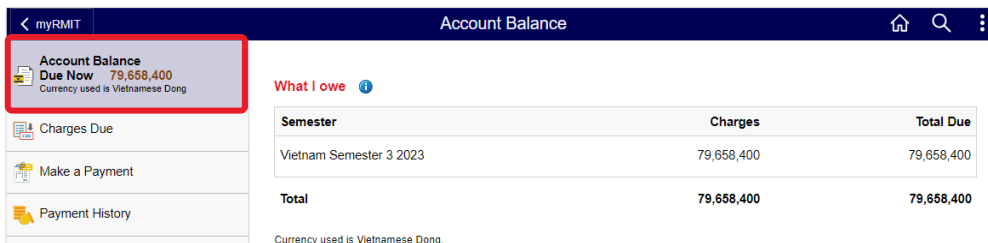
The **myRMIT home page** displays. Click the **Financial Account** tile to access the Account Balance section of myRMIT.



Financial Account page opens displaying the **Account Balance** page.

1. Account Balance

The **Account Balance** page displays a summary of the amount that you are due to pay, by Semester. You can only view information here.



The **Charges** column displays the total of fees and charges for the Semester.

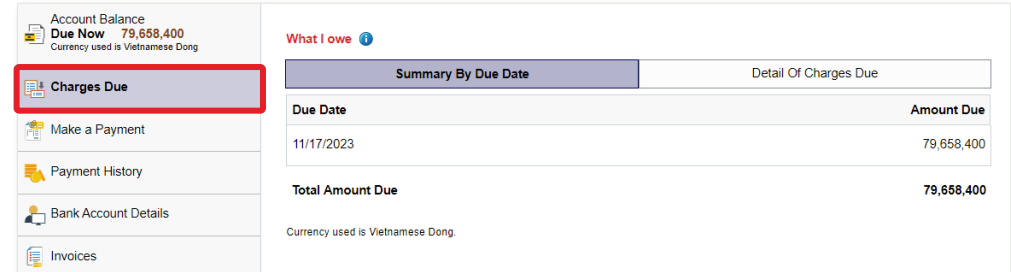
The **Total Due** column displays how much is outstanding for each Semester. If a credit balance is shown here, this indicates the amount of money that is held in your account.

2. Charges Due

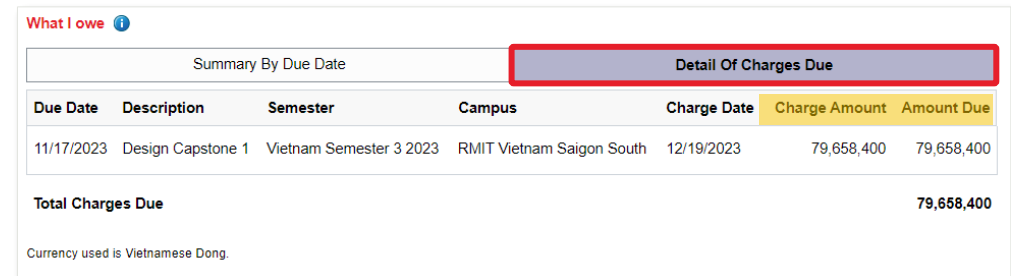
Click the **Charges Due** page to view details of the charges due such as due date, description or reason for charge etc.

The **Charges Due** page opens displaying the **Summary by Due Date** tab.

Click the **Summary by Due Date** tab to view the amount that must be paid and the due date of the charge.



Click the **Details of Charges Due** tab to view a breakdown of each course fee and other charges (if any).



The **Charge Amount** column displays the full amount of each fee or charge. The **Amount Due** column displays how much is outstanding for each fee or charge.

3. Make a Payment

Click the **Make a Payment** page to indicate the charges that you are ready to pay. The **Make a Payment** page has three steps that you need to complete.

Step 1: Select a Payment Method

You can view the available options for online payment here.

Click the **Confirm** button to continue.

Step 2: Specify Payment Amount

Step 1. Enter the amount in the **Payment Amount** column. Any overdue amount must be paid first.

Step 2. Click the **Confirm** button to continue.

Step 3: Confirm Payment Amount

Click the **Confirm** button to go to **RMIT's online payment system** and make the payment.

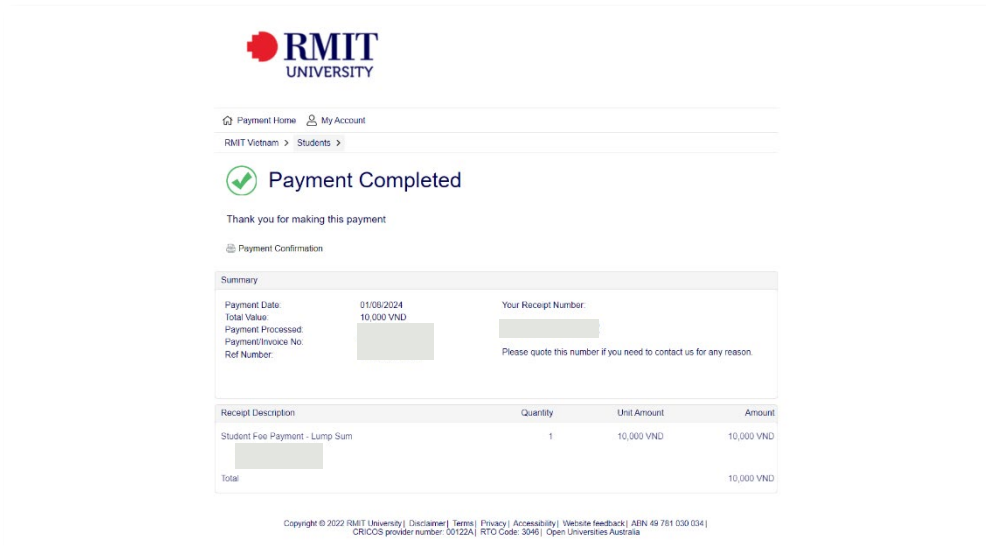
Step 4: You will be redirected to the **Payment Using OnePay Vietnam** page.

Step 6: Enter your details and click **Pay Now**.

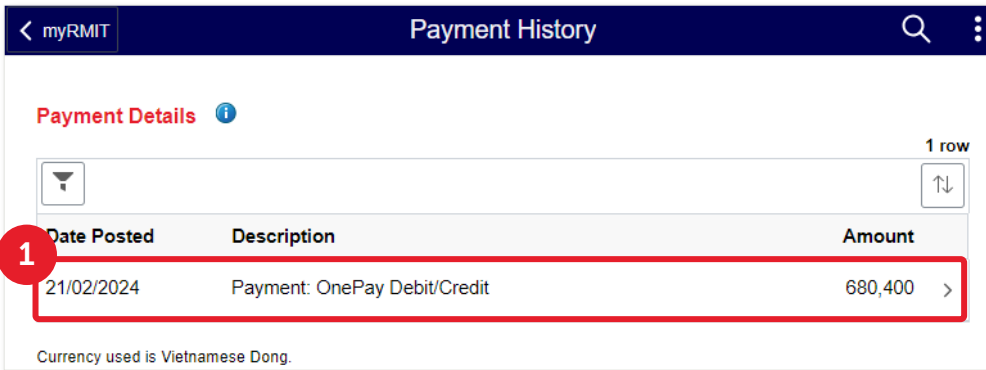
Step 7: Payment Completed page will be displayed. You will also receive a payment confirmation via email.



4. Payment History
