Vietnam	High school graduation diploma with minimum of Year 12 GPA of 7.0, or equivalent	Successfully complete RMIT Vietnam English Advanced, or one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ IELTS (Academic) 6.5 (no band below 6.0) ▪ TOEFL iBT 79 (with minimum score of 13 in Reading, 12 in Listening, 18 in Speaking and 21 in Writing) ▪ Pearson Test of English (Academic) 58 (no communication band below 50) ▪ C1 Advanced (CAE) or C2 Proficiency (CPE) 176 (no less than 169 in any component)
China	High school graduation diploma with one of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Gao San (Senior Middle 3) (Year 12) with minimum average of 75%; or ▪ Gao Kao (National College Entrance Examination, NCEE) - Beijing of 441 Gao Kao score is for Beijing municipality only. Note: You can gain entry to our undergraduate programs through pathways like Foundation Studies and UniSTART Academic. Previous study and proficiency tests are recognised for two years from the completion date or test date to the program commencement date unless stated otherwise.
