



The cost of living in Vietnam can vary depending on your lifestyle and location within the country. Our student services can help you find accommodation that suits your needs. While you're studying, it is important to have a home base where you feel comfortable and secure. Here's a rough estimate of monthly expenses for international students in Hanoi and HCMC:

Item	Description	Approximate cost/month (USD)	
Rent	Although rental prices can certainly differ, finding shared or private accommodation is relatively easy and has a range of options available.	\$250 - \$600	
Food	Both Hanoi and HCMC offer a wide range of dining options. Eating at local street food stalls can be very affordable, with meals costing as little as \$2 to \$3. Dining in restaurants or more upscale eateries may cost around \$5 to \$10 per meal.	\$250 is recommended	
Utilities	Make sure to cost utilities (electricity, water, gas, phone and internet) into your monthly budget.	\$50 - \$100	
Transportation	Public transportation is relatively affordable in Vietnam. Taxi fares are around \$0.5 per kilometre. There are also ride-sharing apps like Grab (similar to Uber) available.	Transportation costs may amount from \$50 - \$70	
Approximate total	These estimates can vary significantly based on your individual choices and preferences. Factors like type of accommodation, dietary preferences, and personal spending habits all go into a budget. For international students to create a detailed budget plan to manage their expenses effectively during their stay in Vietnam.	A total monthly budget ranging between \$600 - \$1000

Transfer: Start your program in Vietnam and then apply to permanently transfer to Melbourne.



Dual Campus: Secure your international education journey right at the start of your studies. Enjoy one year at RMIT Vietnam then head to RMIT Melbourne for 2-3 years to finish your degree.

Note: If you transfer your program to RMIT in Melbourne or join a full program there, you will pay the Australian tuition rate.

Go on exchange

From your second year onward, you can go on an exchange program to RMIT in Melbourne (Australia) or choose from a list of our partner universities. You can study for one or two semesters while continuing to pay your RMIT Vietnam tuition rate.
